



Recorder, Flute, Clarinet & Saxophone lessons

Sarah Grose is an experienced musician and woodwind teacher who teaches at many schools in West Sussex. Sarah will be offering woodwind lessons after half term at school during Friday lunchtimes. She teaches the recorder, flute, clarinet and saxophone and lessons can be either on a group or individual basis. Group lessons are a fun way for children to start learning; individual lessons mean that a child gets focussed attention right from the beginning of their learning. Age recommendations for which instruments are suitable to start learning should also be based on the size of a child so it is more of a guideline. Recorder is a very good way to introduce younger children to music and lead them on to further woodwind instruments.

Recorder – years 1-2 upwards

Flute – year 3 upwards

Clarinet – year 5 upwards

Saxophone – year 5 upwards
